Therabotanics Supplements, LLC and our affiliated entities (collectively, “*Company*”, “*us*”, or “*we*”) care about your privacy. As such we are providing this Privacy Policy (“*Policy*”) to help you understand what data we collect, how we use it, who we share it with, and your rights with respect to this data. This Policy applies when you use our services through our Websites (“*Websites*”) linked to this Policy, as well as our mobile sites, mobile applications, or pages operated by us on social networking sites and other platforms (collectively, the “*Services*”).

By visiting the Website or using our Services, you consent to the collection, use, maintenance, and disclosure of information as described in this Policy. If you do not agree with this Policy, please do not visit our Website or use the Services.

Residents in California, Colorado, Connecticut, and Virginia should refer to the body of this Privacy Notice as well as the "[Jurisdiction-Specific Notices](#)" section below for additional information that may be applicable to them.

I. What Information is Collected and How We Collect It.

When we use the term “*personal data*” or “*personal information*” in this Policy, we mean information that identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, to you. It does not include aggregated, deidentified, or anonymous data (“*Aggregated Data*”) that is maintained in a form that is not reasonably capable of being associated with or linked to you.

We may collect, use, store, and transfer different kinds of personal data about you that we have categorized as follows:

1. **Information You Provide.** We collect information in several ways, such as when you:
 - register for an account;

We also collect, use, and share Aggregated Data for any purpose. Examples include aggregated statistical or demographic data or data provided in hashed, non-human readable form. For example, we may aggregate your usage data on how you use the Services (“*Usage Data*”) to calculate the percentage of users accessing a specific Website feature. Aggregated Data may be derived from your personal data but does not directly or indirectly identify you and therefore does not amount to personal data.

II. How We Use Collected Information

Generally, we will use your information in the following circumstances:

- To process and fulfill orders and purchases through our Services and to keep you informed about the status of your order.
- To provide customer service.
- To permit you to and facilitate participation in sweepstakes, contests, and similar promotions.
- To personalize your experience and customize content on our Services relevant to your interests, including but not limited to targeted offers and ads through our Website, email, social media channels, third-party sites, or on other devices you may use.
- To operate, maintain, and provide to you the features and functionality of the Services.
- To send you important information regarding the Services, such as certain changes to our terms, conditions, policies, and other administrative information. As this information may be material to your use of the Services, you may not opt out of receiving such communications.
- To inform you of products, programs, services, and promotions that we believe may be of interest to you.
- To help maintain the safety, security, and integrity of our Services, technology assets, and business.
- For our internal business purposes.
- Where it is necessary for our legitimate interests, or those of a third party, and your interests and fundamental rights do not override those interests.
- Where we need to comply with a legal or regulatory obligation.
- Where we need to enforce our corporate reporting obligations, our Terms of Use, or to comply with applicable laws.
- For purposes disclosed at the time you provide your personal data or as otherwise set forth in this Policy.

We will generally only use your personal data for the purposes for which we collected it. If we need to use your personal data for an unrelated purpose, we will notify you. Please note that we may process your personal data without your knowledge or consent, in compliance with the above rules, where and when required or permitted by law.

III. How We Disclose Collected Information

We disclose personal information as necessary to operate our business, such as in connection with providing our Services to you. In general, we may share your personal data with the parties listed below:

- Company affiliates and subsidiaries, to provide you with the Services.
- Unaffiliated third-party service providers, consultants, and other vendors that perform functions or services on our behalf and under our instructions to make the Website and our Services available to you.
- Advertising networks and technology companies that measure advertising performance and attribution on the Website.

- With your consent or at your direction.

We may also share Aggregated Data with third parties.

Cookie Notice

We use cookies and similar tools across our Sites to improve their performance and security and to enhance your user experience. This Cookie Notice explains how we do that.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files which a website may put on your computer or mobile device when you first visit a site or page. The cookie will help the website to recognize your device the next time you visit. Cookies may be used to remember your preferences and to help you navigate within a website. Web beacons or similar technology have similar functions. We use the term "cookies" in this Cookie Notice to refer to cookies as well as web beacons, pixels, or similar technologies.

There are many functions cookies serve. For example, they can help us to remember your username and preferences, analyze how well our Sites are performing and allow us to recommend content we believe will be most relevant to you.

Certain cookies contain personal information – for example, if you click to "remember me" when logging in, a cookie will store your username.

What sort of cookies does the Company use?

1. ESSENTIAL COOKIES

Some cookies are essential for the operation of our Sites. For example, some cookies allow us to identify registered users and ensure they can access the subscription-only pages, or they may facilitate page navigation or assist with security checks.

2. PERFORMANCE COOKIES

We utilize other cookies to analyze how our visitors use our Sites and to monitor website performance. For example, we might use performance cookies to keep track of which pages are most popular, which method of linking between pages is most effective, and to determine why some pages are receiving error messages.

3. FUNCTIONALITY COOKIES

We use functionality cookies to allow us to remember your preferences. For example, cookies save you the trouble of typing in your username every time you access the site, and recall your preferences, such as which sections of the Sites you want to see when you log in.

4. BEHAVIORALLY TARGETED ADVERTISING COOKIES
